What is Adopt-A-Day?

PPHFH Adopt-A-Day is an opportunity for groups to have an enriched team-building experience while volunteering on a Habitat construction site. Ten volunteers will spend the day building and will receive lunch on the site, Habitat T-shirts, and a framed photo of your group.

Pikes Peak Habitat created the Adopt-A-Day sponsorship program in order to match the growing demand for affordable housing with the high demand of group volunteer opportunities. The program allows organizations to support Habitat by contributing to the cost of materials in addition to providing volunteer support.

What does Adopt-A-Day cost?

The cost for groups to participate is \$1,500, which is the average cost of one day's building materials and supervision. This money directly benefits a Habitat partner family and contributes to the mission of building simple, decent, affordable houses in El Paso County.

We truly value volunteers' donation of time. By donating the cost of materials, you allow Habitat to make an even greater impact on families that would otherwise never experience permanent homeownership.

Are there other benefits to scheduling an Adopt-A-Day?

Yes! Pikes Peak Habitat's volunteer schedule is a three-month rolling calendar. For example, January 1 people are able to schedule dates in January, February and March. But, Adopt-A-Day groups can schedule any available Thursday, Friday or Saturday throughout the year. So, if you have a special day in mind for your group that is outside our normal three-month schedule you may book it as an Adopt-A-Day group.
